## **Unattended Child Policy**

In order to maintain a safe environment and promote an atmosphere where reading and studying can be encouraged:

- 1. Parents/Guardians are responsible for the conduct of their minor (under age 18) children in the library and on library grounds.
- 2. For their safety and security, children under ten (10) years of age must be supervised by a caregiver who remains with the child at all times.

The Library is not a childcare center and cannot legally function as such (N.J.S.A. 30:5B-1-15). It is the responsibility of the parent or caregiver to be accessible, at any time, to pick up any minor left unattended in the Library. If a parent cannot be located, the police will be notified, as that child will be considered abandoned (N.J.S.A. 9:6-8.21).

3. If a child under ten (10) years of age is left unattended at the library or on library grounds, staff will call the parents/guardians or their designee to collect the child.
